Type of Hero: Please check one

- Medalist Hero:** A Summit County citizen who *puts their life at risk* to save the life of another or assist in a life threatening situation (examples: running into a burning house; pulling someone out of a burning car; rescuing someone drowning, etc.)
- Distinguished Hero:** A Summit County Citizen who saves the life of another or assists in a life threatening situation (examples: performs CPR, choking maneuver; administers First Aid, etc.)
- Professional Rescue Hero:** A professional worker who goes above and beyond the call of duty to save the life of another while on the job; this includes those individuals who volunteer their services (examples: firemen, policemen, paramedics, nurses, doctors, etc.). These will be chosen by a professional peer review committee.
- Animal Hero:** An animal who deserves recognition for assisting in saving the life of a human (examples: police dog who saves a handler, seeing eye dog who rescues an owner, etc.).
