Cancellations and Refunds

Registrations are received until class is filled. Payment is required at time of registration. Although we strive to conduct all scheduled classes, some classes may be cancelled due to insufficient enrollment (or our need to respond to a disaster). In such cases, students will be notified in advance and given the opportunity to reschedule or receive a refund.

To receive a full refund, students who wish to withdraw from a course – as well as those who wish to reschedule to a later course – must notify the Red Cross at least three (3) business days prior to the first day of the scheduled class. Otherwise, a \$10.00 service fee will be charged.

We strongly encourage students to arrive for classes at least 10 minutes early. Due to our curriculum, classes MUST start on time and students arriving late CANNOT be admitted. Late-arriving students are not eligible for a refund.

Course Completion Requirements

Most of our courses offer a certification upon completion of the course. To be eligible for certification, students must:

- Attend all class sessions.
- Participate in all skill sessions and scenarios.
- Demonstrate competency in all required skills.
- Score at least 80% on a written knowledge assessment.

For specific certification requirements, contact our offices. Students who do not fulfill all of the above requirements cannot be certified and are not eligible for a refund.
